To our Northstar Community,

During the 2020-2021 school year, we *blazed a trail* through Northstar Academy's 25th anniversary year. A trail full of possibilities, hope, and excitement as our students and faculty navigated the school year. We are grateful for our supporters who ensured we had the resources needed throughout the year. Northstar's accomplishments are your accomplishments.



In 2021-2022, we continued our growth as we moved *onward & upward*. This year's school theme has been poignant. *Onward & Upward* is a reflection of the hopes and dreams we have for our students and the future.

Over the last two years, our students have made great strides in their academic journeys. On the academic campus, all of our seniors graduated or are on track to graduate. At the close of the 2020-2021 school year, 64% enrolled in post-secondary education programs, and 21% directly entered the workforce.

Our Career Academy students have also worked hard to achieve much these past two years. Despite the pandemic's affect on our ability to provide worksite experiences, our faculty and students overcame these hurdles. In 2021-2022, students earned a total of 65 industry credentials with 79% of students earning at least one industry credential. All of our graduating students left with a plan in place, and we even had one graduate working to start her own business!

With a move to our new school campus imminent, Northstar is starting a new era. All of our students will be on the same campus for the first time in nearly ten years and this expansion allows us to aid more students with disabilities than ever before. We would not be able to enter this exciting new chapter without you and your support, and for that, we cannot thank you enough.

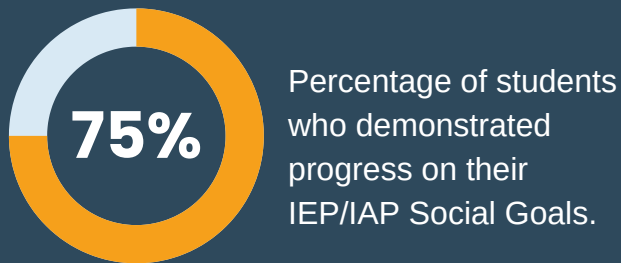

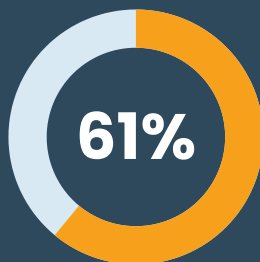

“Often,” says veteran art teacher Kira Rhorer, “students haven’t had the attention or interest to draw until they come to Northstar.” A middle school student, Maxwell, discovered his love of creating art.

“I didn’t used to draw,” says Maxwell, “but now I love to do it. You can make anything you want.”

Through his artwork, Maxwell is able to enhance his fine motor skills while simultaneously expressing himself in a new way. As art is a skill that gets better with practice, Maxwell continues to hone his craft, both inside and outside the classroom.

Take What You Need

Sometimes we all need a friendly reminder of how special we are! Northstar's lower school students created several tearable tag "Free Compliments" posters. Each colorful poster was hung in high traffic areas that were easily accessible to everyone at Northstar. Tags featured messages such as "*You are kind!*" and "*I like your style!*" that a passersby could tear off and keep for themselves or give to a friend. These posters are an example of student-led exercises intended to foster a sense of belonging and help Northstar students build relationships in their community.

My grades were superb and weren't greatly affected by my lack of communication in the classroom.

By the end of the second marking period I was beginning to question my reasoning for completing high school. Ridiculous, I know. With the end in sight I became anxious due to the fact that I had no idea what the plan was for life after graduation.

A plan to finish this school year was concocted in my IEP meeting. Attend Northstar for a week and see how it goes. That's it. That week would determine if attending school in person would help with my depression. And it did. Of course the anxiety returned the first few days and even the following weeks, but I connected more than ever with the support provided to me by Northstar.

I was able to better my understanding of myself with each session with Dr. Bunting, increase my passion for learning with each class, and was even able to attend prom for my one and only time.

I still stumbled and fell throughout my time in person at Northstar, but I now had the ability to pick myself up. Northstar helped me see life outside the cage and gave me the power to not be so afraid of the tiger.

In the fall of 2021 I plan on having a stable job and taking a few courses at a community college. I might also be participating in Career Academy. I want to learn more and I want to become the best me that I can be intellectually. In the long run, I hope to work in the educational system, write a book or a movie or both, create a video game, and more.

Thank you to everyone at Northstar for supporting me and helping me whenever I needed it. Everyone here deserves much appreciation for all they've done. Thank you Northstar for helping me tame the tigers and overall being a positive space for me to thrive.

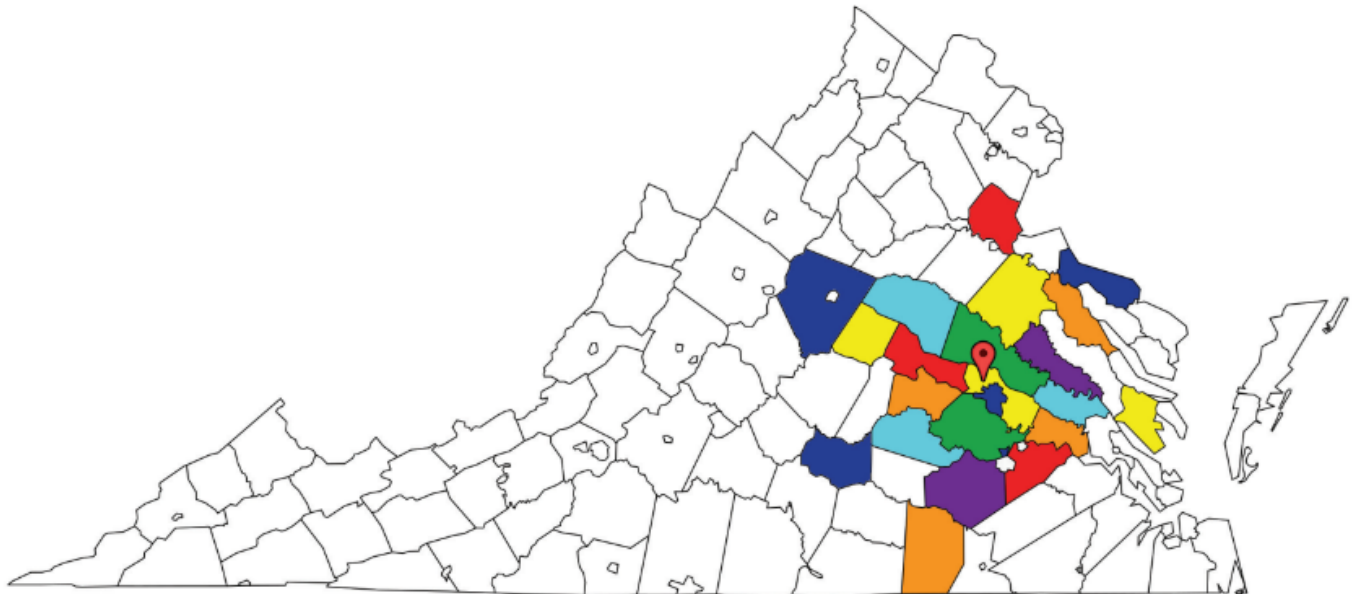
